- 55 to 69%: 7 responses
- Below 55%: 3 responses

2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

- Thoroughly: 50 responses
- Satisfactorily: 50 responses
- Poorly or Indifferently: 19 responses

3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

- Always effective: 85 responses
- Sometimes effective: 15 responses
- Just satisfactorily: 12 responses
- Poor communication: 7 responses

4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

- Excellent: 51 responses
- Very good: 49 responses
- Good: 17 responses
- Fair: 2 responses

5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.

- Always fair: 78 responses
- Usually fair: 22 responses
- Sometimes unfair: 14 responses

6. Teachers illustrate concepts through examples and applications.

- Every time: 45 responses
- Usually: 35 responses
- Occasionally: 10 responses
- Never: 5 responses

7. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you accordingly.

- Fully: 48 responses
- Reasonably: 40 responses
- Occasionally: 7 responses

8. Teachers help in identifying weaknesses and overcoming them.

- Somewhat: 35 responses

11. Teachers encourage participation in extracurricular activities.

- Strongly agree: 45 responses
- Neutral: 40 responses
- Disagree: 5 responses

12. Efforts are made by the institute to inculcate soft skills and employability skills.

- To a great extent: 55 responses
- Moderately: 35 responses
- Little effort: 5 responses

13. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projectors, multimedia, etc.?

- Above 90%: 40 responses
- 70–89%: 30 responses
- 50–69%: 20 responses
- Below 50%: 5 responses

14. Overall quality of the teaching-learning process in your institute.

- Strongly agree: 50 responses
- Agree: 40 responses
- Neutral: 10 responses

Key Findings & Recommendations

- **Positive Aspects:**
 - A majority of students (85%) agree that the syllabus coverage was extensive (above 70%).
 - Communication and approach of teachers were rated highly by most students.
 - Fairness in internal evaluation received positive feedback.
 - 90% of students found that teachers use examples and applications effectively.
- **Areas for Improvement:**
 - More faculty members should be encouraged to use ICT tools in teaching.

- o Student-centric learning methodologies can be expanded.
- o Increased focus on extracurricular activities and soft skill development.

Conclusion

The overall feedback from students is highly positive, with most aspects receiving favorable ratings. Some areas, such as technology integration and extracurricular participation, can be further enhanced to improve student engagement and satisfaction.
